Measures on the Ballot

A. ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPECIAL PARCEL TAX FOR PUBLIC

SAFETY. To support local law enforcement activities, shall an ordinance be adopted imposing an annual special parcel tax amounting to: (i) \$400/unit upon developed multi-family residences or apartments; (ii) \$500/unit upon all other developed parcels; (iii) \$100/unit upon developed parcels for senior citizens; (iv) \$50/unit upon undeveloped parcels for senior citizens; and (v) \$100/parcel for all other undeveloped parcels?

B. ORDINANCE INCREASING THE SALES AND USE TAX FOR PUBLIC SAFETY.
