ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

APPROVING INCREASE OF TRANSACTIONS AND USE (SALES) TAX FROM CURRENT RATE .980% TO 1.980% FOR PUBLIC SAFETY. The proposed ordinance would approve the increase of the City's current sales and use tax rate (.980%) by one percent (1.980%). The funds raised through the one percent increase shall be dedicated to and expended only for purposes of providing local law enforcement services. The authority to levy the tax would continue in perpetuity. Otherwise, the current sales tax ordinance would otherwise remain unchanged. Arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the Fresno County Clerk/Elections, 2221 Kern St., Fresno, CA 93721, no later than Friday, June 16, 2017 by 5:00pm. Paper copies of arguments must be submitted with original signatures, as well as on CD in MS Word format. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the legislative body, or any member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or argument submitted. If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only
